Fishing The Lake:

Use any form of watercraft, e.g. pontoon, float tube, canoe and kayak. Electric trolling motors only. *This is a fly-fishing only lake*.

Flies: Nymphs, Wooly Buggers, Caddis, etc

Fish: Triploids, Browns, Cutthroats

Lines: Sinking or medium line during the day; dry in the evening if a Hex hatch
